Presentation:

Terrible and numerous wars plague us, wars that threaten to destroy the foundations of democracy and the survival of future generations.

Fanatical Islamism views others as strangers, infidels, enemies to be fought and defeated. But the West has also fought and is still fighting countless wars within and beyond its borders, despite its Christian roots.

The winds of war of recent months have upended Europe and the world, violating every rule of international law and every economic, ethical, and moral foundation of human coexistence.

Peace cannot exist without law and justice, as Greek philosophy teaches us, but it is only in the absence of war, that is, in peace, that justice can be achieved and the emergence of new conflicts prevented.

The need to establish an intercultural dialogue, to achieve a profound "cultural disarmament," as suggested by the philosopher and theologian Raimon Panikkar, who highlighted the need to disarm our respective cultures together with (and sometimes even before) the elimination of weapons, appears increasingly urgent.
